**RESOLUTION DEFINING AND ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM
PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR THE PROPOSED COUNTYWIDE SERVICE
DISTRICT TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES**

WHEREAS N.C.G.S. 153A-301 authorizes the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners to establish and define a service district in order to finance, provide, or maintain for the district certain services in addition to or to a greater extent than those financed, provided, or maintained for the entire county; and

WHEREAS Forsyth County has established countywide fire fighting resources to support all volunteer fire departments serving the unincorporated areas and Clemmons, Lewisville, Tobaccoville, and Bethania (collectively “the Countywide Area”), by sending County fire fighters from different stations across the County to aid in first response;

WHEREAS it would be advantageous to establish a countywide service district to fund such countywide fire fighting resources;

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on March 14, 2019, regarding the establishment of a fire service district to include all territories within the Countywide Area;

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C.G.S. 153A-309.2, the County will publish a notice of such public hearing on two occasions, more than two weeks before March 14, 2019; and

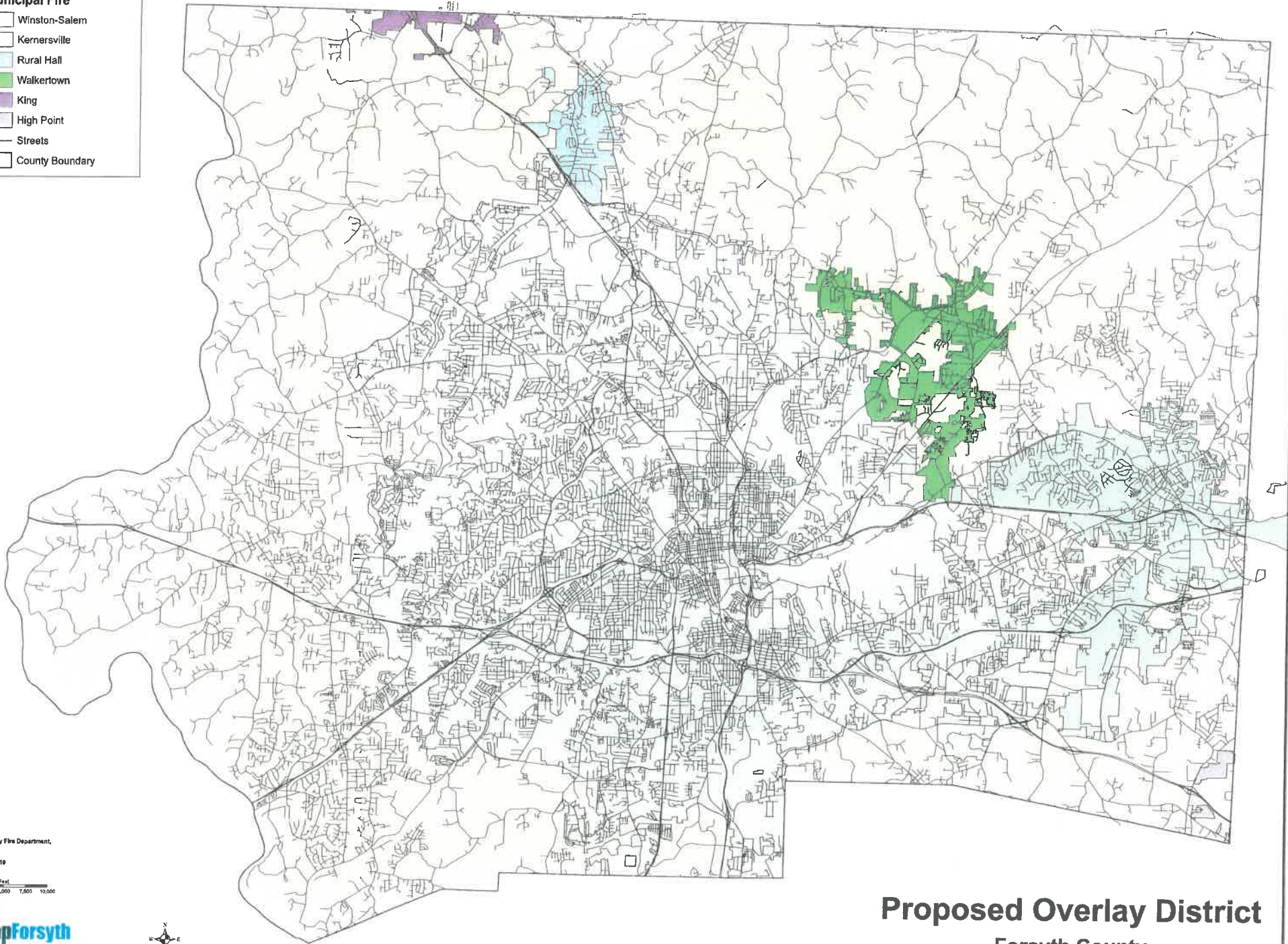
WHEREAS the property tax rate necessary to fund such countywide resources will be far less than a rate of fifteen cents (15¢) on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of property subject to taxation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that property taxes for the proposed fire service district to serve the Countywide Area may not be levied in excess of a rate of fifteen cents (15¢) on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of property subject to taxation; and

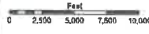
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the Clerk to the Board is hereby directed to make such publications of the notice of public hearing regarding the proposed new service district as set forth in N.C.G.S. 153A-309.2(b).
