# RESOLUTION APPROVING ASECOND REVISION TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 HOME AND COMMUNITY CARE BLOCK GRANT FUNDING PLAN FOR OLDER ADULTS AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT THE REVISED PLAN FOR STATE APPROVAL (AGING SERVICES)

**WHEREAS**as the Lead Area Agency, the primary responsibility of Piedmont Triad Regional Council (PTRC) is to plan and coordinate the development of the County funding plan for local service agencies for the elderly through the Home and Community Care Block Grant (HCCBG) funding plan, which is then submitted to the N.C. Department of Health & Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, for approval;

**WHEREAS**the Forsyth County HCCBG Committee recommends a revision to the fiscal year 2020-2021HCCBG County funding plan based on the release of \$72,818 from Forsyth County Department of Social Services for In-Home Level 1 services;

**WHEREAS**of the \$72,818being released, the Shepherd's Center of Greater Winston-Salem, Inc., will receive \$10,000 additional funding for senior center operations and Senior Services, Inc., will receive \$30,818 additional funding for home delivered meals, \$12,000 for congregate nutrition, and \$20,000 for Information and Options Counseling;

**WHEREAS** in addition to this revision, the Winston-Salem Transit Authority is requesting to move \$93,289 from General Transportation to Medical Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**the proposed revisions to the said funding plan must be submitted to the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners for approval before submission to the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, for approval;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the attached revised fiscal year 2020-2021HCCBG County Funding Plan for older adults and authorizes the Chairman or County Manager and Clerk to the Board or their designees to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, any necessary documents to submit the revised County Funding Plan to the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, through the Piedmont Triad Regional Council subject to approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney, and apre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable.
